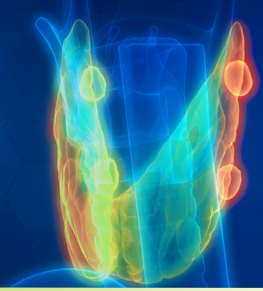

Thyroid Cancer Testing Program

Lilly Oncology Sponsors Molecular Testing through NeoGenomics for Advanced Thyroid Cancer Patients

Thyroid cancer represents about 1% of all human cancers with medullary thyroid cancer (MTC) as one of the most aggressive forms, accounting for 5-10% of all thyroid cancers and 13.4% of all thyroid cancer-related deaths.¹

A genomic test for thyroid cancer can identify any actionable alteration that can inform therapeutic decisions.



The Thyroid Cancer Testing Program is designed to provide access to molecular testing for appropriate advanced thyroid cancer patients (US-based only), including:

- Advanced or metastatic medullary thyroid cancer (MTC) patients 12 years of age and older who require systemic therapy
- Advanced or metastatic non-medullary thyroid cancer (non-MTC) patients 12 years of age and older who require systemic therapy and who are radioactive iodine-refractory (if radioactive iodine is appropriate)



Eligible patients may receive either one (1) NGS Thyroid Profile test (for MTC) or one (1) NGS Thyroid Profile plus RET FISH test (for non-MTC), regardless of test results or treatment decision.

Enroll your thyroid cancer patients today for a molecular test at no cost!

1. Fill out the **Thyroid Cancer Testing Program Test Request Form**
2. **Submit patient tissue sample** to NeoGenomics along with the completed Test Request Form
3. **Receive test results** through your preferred method of delivery within 14 days of receipt of the patient sample.

-  **What is the Thyroid Cancer Testing Program?**
The **Thyroid Cancer Testing Program** is a Lilly Oncology-sponsored program offering molecular testing at no cost to appropriate thyroid cancer patients (US-based only). Lilly will cover the cost of the test regardless of the test results and treatment decision.
-  **Who is eligible for the Thyroid Cancer Testing Program?**
Any US-based **patient 12 years of age and older** with advanced or metastatic medullary thyroid cancer (“MTC”) who requires systemic therapy or with advanced or metastatic non-medullary thyroid cancer (“non-MTC”) who requires systemic therapy and who is radioactive iodine-refractory (if radioactive iodine is appropriate) is eligible to enroll in the Thyroid Cancer Testing Program to receive genomic cancer testing at no cost.
- Patients who have not previously undergone biopsy may still enroll in the program, but are responsible for working with their physician to extract a viable tumor specimen and cover any associated expenses.
-  **What tests will be done?**
All eligible patients who enroll in the Thyroid Cancer Testing Program will receive either **one (1) NGS Thyroid Profile test** (for MTC patients) or **one (1) NGS Thyroid Profile plus RET FISH test** (for non-MTC patients).
-  **What are the specimen requirements?**
NeoGenomics offers NGS testing for thyroid cancer on formalin-fixed paraffin-embedded (FFPE) tissue. **Paraffin block is preferred.** Please use **10% buffered formalin fixative.** Do not use zinc fixative.
-  **When can I expect results?**
Results will be sent to the ordering physician’s office or laboratory within **14 days** after sample is received.
-  **What type of insurance coverage do my patients need to participate?**
Any patient meeting the eligibility criteria can enroll in the program **regardless of insurance coverage.**
-  **Will there be any cost to my patient?**
There will be **no cost for patients**, healthcare providers or insurance companies for the NGS or FISH tests.
-  **What if I get a bill?**
No bill will be sent to patients, healthcare providers or insurance companies who participate through this program. If a bill is received in error, please disregard or contact NeoGenomics at **866.776.5907, option 3.**
-  **How do I order supplies?**
